The Strata Resilience Program assists strata properties that are located within 100 kilometres of the coastline from Rockhampton, north to the Torres Strait and west to the Queensland/Northern Territory border. The program follows the delivery of the Strata Title Inspection Program (Inspection Program) conducted by James Cook University on behalf of the Queensland Government since 2018. The Inspection Program gave bodies corporate information about the existing resilience of their properties and strategies to improve them
Eligible bodies corporate can apply for a grant of up to \$15,000 per residential tenancy to a maximum of \$150,000 (including GST) per body corporate.
The program operates through a co-contribution arrangement. Funding covers 75% of eligible approved resilient works. The approved body corporate must be able to make a minimum 25% co-contribution towards the works. This is paid directly to the contractor.
To apply, bodies corporate must meet all these criteria:
