Eligibility requirements

The Strata Resilience Program assists strata properties that are located within 100 kilometres of the coastline from Rockhampton, north to the Torres Strait and west to the Queensland/Northern Territory border. The program follows the delivery of the Strata Title Inspection Program (Inspection Program) conducted by James Cook University on behalf of the Queensland Government since 2018. The Inspection Program gave bodies corporate information about the existing resilience of their properties and strategies to improve them.

Eligible bodies corporate can apply for a grant of up to \$15,000 per residential tenancy to a maximum of \$150,000 (including GST) per body corporate.

The program operates through a co-contribution arrangement. Funding covers 75% of eligible approved resilient works. The approved body corporate must be able to make a minimum 25% co-contribution towards the works. This is paid directly to the contractor.

To apply, bodies corporate must meet all these criteria:

- have participated in the Inspection Program
- have the funds to meet co-contribution requirements
- be located within 100 kilometres of the coastline from Rockhampton, north to the Torres Strait and west to the Queensland/Northern Territory border
- have a single point of contact for the program (i.e. strata contact person) who will seek approval for works in line with the *Body Corporate and Community Management Act 1997*.

Your contribution

The program operates through a co-payment arrangement. The funding covers 75% of the costs of approved eligible resilience strategies, up to a maximum of \$150,000. The body corporate must contribute a minimum of 25% of the approved works identified through the Inspection Program Report or resilience works exceeding the \$150,000 incl GST.

For example, where a quote of resilience works is \$120,000 incl GST, the program would fund \$90,000, with the body corporate required to fund \$30,000.

- The funding provided by the state is to be used only for approved eligible resilience strategies and is not to be used for any other purpose.
- While the purpose of the program is to fund mitigation works designed to improve resilience against future cyclone or storm damage to the property, carrying out the works may not necessarily have this effect. The Queensland Government does not warrant that the mitigation works for which funding is provided will prevent future cyclone or storm damage to the property.
- Funding would only be provided if the application is accepted and would only be provided for 75% of the actual costs of completed eligible resilience strategies works, up to a maximum of \$150,000 inclusive of any GST. No further funding will be provided.
- The provision of funding by the state of Queensland or the Department of Housing, Local Government, Planning and Public Works does not create any employment or agency relationship with the nominated person or the contractor engaged by me to provide the mitigation works.

For example, if the contractor engaged to provide the mitigation works for the purpose of the program identifies any works which must be carried out to allow the contractor to complete the mitigation works, the state is not liable for the additional costs incurred by the contractor (e.g. extra work discovered after the job starts to fix termite problems, timber rot or asbestos issues).
